In 2022, the Sumner County Museum outlined its 10-year vision, the most ambitious and impacting since its inception. Historic Stonewall was restored to its more original state and upgraded with needed amenities such as two new HVAC units. The goal: Open the house as an Airbnb to create a historic overnight experience for both locals and visitors. For those staying at Stonewall, history will come to life. This opportunity is drawing visitors into downtown Gallatin and will provide a source of revenue to the Museum, helping further the vision of both sharing and making history in Sumner County.


YOUR SUPPORT WILL ...

Establish the Museum's distilling display after the renovation of **The Shop.** This space will be owned by the Museum and rented/used by distillery and brewery investors. The space allows for a museum display and small batch operation on site using antique distilling methods. It would become a destination for locals and tourists, and event venue, all while introducing the history of distilling and prohibition in Sumner County (of which, artifacts are already on hand at the Museum, ready to be displayed).

Update the historic **Carriage House** in two ways: the extensive first floor footprint allows for an art and cultural center, featuring local artists, small classes, meeting spaces, a potential coffee shop/wine bar, and more. This opportunity exists to create a space to showcase history for the community from both an artistic and cultural perspective. The upstairs space would be converted into office spaces that would provide both space and rental income for the Museum

Upgrade the current **Museum** space to reduce operating costs, tell Sumner stories, create more hands-on experiences, and better showcase artifacts and inform guests about the items on display. With thousands of Sumner County historical items available, your support would help update the environment to re-engage the community and attract visitors of all ages.
